Instructions to Login to Outcomes Parent Portal

The email address that was provided upon registration would be the one that you would need to login. If you need to update your email, please let the school know at either marynoella.marshall@eskasonischool.ca or to newell.johnson@eskasonischool.ca.

1. Log in to: <https://outcomesfn.ednet.ns.ca/parent/parentpage.jsp>
2. If you are using Parentpage for the first time, you will not have a password. Click on the button on the front page: “**Click here if you have forgotten your password**”. Then enter your email address and click “**Send**”. The program will generate a random password and email it to you.
3. You must use the same email address that the school has entered into the system that you provided on the registration forms.
4. When you get your password by email, return to the Parentpage and log in using your email address for the username, and the password you have been given. If you do not receive the email, check your junk folder because some email filters might not recognize the email address. Hotmail addresses often go to the junk folder.
5. Once you log in, you will see your child’s records that have been linked to your email address.
6. You can change your password at this point by clicking the “**change password**” button.
